SCOPE AND CONTENT STATEMENT

One volume of session minutes of the Dana church document the founding of the church and the activities of the church.

BIOGRAPHICAL STATEMENT

The Dana church started from the Church of Toronto, which deeded land to church member in Sep. 1889 to build a Presbyterian church in 1889. The Dana Presbyterian church is located in Vermillion County, Indiana on the Illinois border in the central part of the state.

PROVENANCE

Since Hanover College's roots are in Presbyterianism, many records throughout Indiana have been donated at various times to the Presbyterian Archives of Hanover College.

RESTRICTIONS AND PERMISSIONS

The records of the Presbyterian Archives are on deposit at Hanover College and according to the Book of Order (G-9.0406), Hanover College may only hold official records on deposit. All ownership rights to the records remain with the creators of the records (the local church), or in the case the church no longer exists, the presbytery owns the records or the successive church body.
