The Donaldson Presbyterian Church minutes document the meetings of the session from 1853 to 1882.

## **BIOGRAPHICAL STATEMENT**

The Donaldson Presbyterian Church located near Elizabethtown, Indiana applied to the presbytery for a church on Sep. 28, 1853. The church is located in Bartholomew County in the south central part of the state.

## **PROVENANCE**

Since Hanover College's roots are in Presbyterianism, many records throughout Indiana have been donated at various times to the Presbyterian Archives of Hanover College.

## **RESTRICTIONS AND PERMISSIONS**

The records of the Presbyterian Archives are on deposit at Hanover College and according to the Book of Order (G-9.0406), Hanover College may only hold official records on deposit. All ownership rights to the records remain with the creators of the records (the local church), or in the case the church no longer exists, the presbytery owns the records or the successive church body.
