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SCOPE AND CONTENT STATEMENT

The collection contains session minutes and loose papers of the church.

BIOGRAPHICAL STATEMENT

The Elizaville church was organized Oct. 12, 1875 under the direction of the Crawfordsville Presbytery. The church was dissolved on Dec. 14, 1914 and the records were turned into the Crawfordsville Presbytery on Jun. 10, 1916. The church is located in Boone County, Indiana in the central part of the state near Indianapolis.

PROVENANCE

Since Hanover College's roots are in Presbyterianism, many records throughout Indiana have been donated at various times to the Presbyterian Archives of Hanover College.

RESTRICTIONS AND PERMISSIONS

The records of the Presbyterian Archives are on deposit at Hanover College and according to the Book of Order (G-9.0406), Hanover College may only hold official records on deposit. All ownership rights to the records remain with the creators of the records (the local church), or in the case the church no longer exists, the presbytery owns the records or the successive church body.

Materials from the collection may be copied based on the policies and costs determined by the archives. Permission to publish whole documents from the collection, or publication of these materials on the Internet, or any electronic environment, requires a written proposal and permission by the owner of the records.
