## **SCOPE AND CONTENT STATEMENT**

The collection contains early church records of baptisms, session minutes, and Sunday School minutes.

## **BIOGRAPHICAL STATEMENT**

The Graysville Hopewell church is located in Sullivan County, Indiana in the western side of the state bordering Illinois. The records do not state when the church was organized or when it was disbanded.

## **PROVENANCE**

Since Hanover College's roots are in Presbyterianism, many records throughout Indiana have been donated at various times to the Presbyterian Archives of Hanover College.

## **RESTRICTIONS AND PERMISSIONS**

The records of the Presbyterian Archives are on deposit at Hanover College and according to the Book of Order (G-9.0406), Hanover College may only hold official records on deposit. All ownership rights to the records remain with the creators of the records (the local church), or in the case the church no longer exists, the presbytery owns the records or the successive church body.
