SCOPE AND CONTENT STATEMENT

The collection contains session and congregational minutes and treasurer's records.

BIOGRAPHICAL STATEMENT

The collection contains the records of the Greensburg New Zion Church which is primarily 19th century records, and the Greensburg Spring Hill Church records which are 20th century records. When the two church joined or changed locations is not clear from the records. Greensburg is located in Decatur Co., Indiana in southeastern side of the state.

PROVENANCE

Since Hanover College's roots are in Presbyterianism, many records throughout Indiana have been donated at various times to the Presbyterian Archives of Hanover College.

RESTRICTIONS AND PERMISSIONS

The records of the Presbyterian Archives are on deposit at Hanover College and according to the Book of Order (G-9.0406), Hanover College may only hold official records on deposit. All ownership rights to the records remain with the creators of the records (the local church), or in the case the church no longer exists, the presbytery owns the records or the successive church body.
