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SCOPE AND CONTENT STATEMENT

The session minutes of the church from 1832 to 1865 are the only extant records of the church.

BIOGRAPHICAL STATEMENT

The South Marion Presbyterian Church was organized on Jan. 1, 1832 with eight members. On Jan. 24, 1854 the name of the church was changed to the Mount Pleasant Presbyterian Church. The church was dissolved Jun. 16, 1865. The church is located in Marion county, Indiana in the central part of the state near Indianapolis.

PROVENANCE

Since Hanover College's roots are in Presbyterianism, many records throughout Indiana have been donated at various times to the Presbyterian Archives of Hanover College.
