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SCOPE AND CONTENT STATEMENT

The collection contains session minutes, general church minutes, and records of baptisms and communicants.

BIOGRAPHICAL STATEMENT

According to the last entry of the session records the church was first organized in 1814 and was the fourth Presbyterian church organized in the state of Indiana. The Whitewater Presbytery closed the Brookville Presbyterian Church on Sep. 23, 1859 (See Fd. 4 pg. 39.). The Brookville church is located in Franklin County in southeastern border of the state of Indiana and Ohio.

PROVENANCE

Since Hanover College's roots are in Presbyterianism, many records throughout Indiana have been donated at various times to the Presbyterian Archives of Hanover College.

RESTRICTIONS AND PERMISSIONS

The records of the Presbyterian Archives are on deposit at Hanover College and according to the Book of Order (G-9.0406), Hanover College may only hold official records on deposit. All ownership rights to the records remain with the creators of the records (the local church), or in the case the church no longer exists, the presbytery owns the records or the successive church body.

Permission to publish whole documents from the collection, or publication of these materials on the Internet, or any electronic environment, requires a written proposal and permission by the owner of the records.
