The collection contains the session minutes of the church with information about the organization of the church, its meetings, and a list of some members.

## **BIOGRAPHICAL STATEMENT**

The Parkersburg Presbyterian Church was organized around the 1<sup>st</sup> of November 1836 and the first church meeting was held in the third week of August 1837. The church is located in Montgomery county, Indiana, which is west central part of the state.

## **PROVENANCE**

The minute book was at one time owned by Will Ashby. However, a further record of ownership is not found in the records of this archive.

## **RESTRICTIONS AND PERMISSIONS**

The records of the Presbyterian Archives are on deposit at Hanover College and according to the Book of Order (G-9.0406), Hanover College may only hold official records on deposit. All ownership rights to the records remain with the creators of the records (the local church), or in the case the church no longer exists, the presbytery owns the records or the successive church body.
