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SCOPE AND CONTENT STATEMENT

The Pulaski Presbyterian Church minutes include session minutes, congregational minutes and a register church membership.

BIOGRAPHICAL STATEMENT

The church was organized on Oct. 29, 1890 and is located in Pulaski county, Indiana which is in the northwestern part of the state.

PROVENANCE

Since Hanover College's roots are in Presbyterianism, many records throughout Indiana have been donated at various times to the Presbyterian Archives of Hanover College.

RESTRICTIONS AND PERMISSIONS

The records of the Presbyterian Archives are on deposit at Hanover College and according to the Book of Order (G-9.0406), Hanover College may only hold official records on deposit.
