The Kirklin Salem Presbyterian Church is comprised of members from Kirklin, which is located in the southern tip of Clinton county and Salem, which is located in the northern part of Boone county.

PROVENANCE

Since Hanover College's roots are in Presbyterianism, many records throughout Indiana have been donated at various times to the Presbyterian Archives of Hanover College.

RESTRICTIONS AND PERMISSIONS

The records of the Presbyterian Archives are on deposit at Hanover College and according to the Book of Order (G-9.0406), Hanover College may only hold official records on deposit.
