SCOPE AND CONTENT STATEMENT

The College Admission Applications Collection consists of high school records sent by students for application to Hanover College. These high school records include letters of recommendation, and grades. The collection's second series contains applications for admission to Hanover College and includes the standardized blue application form used at that time to apply to Hanover. The records also include correspondence with Pres. Parker, scholarship offers, recommendation letters, and some pictures of the applicants.

PROVENANCE

The high school records used for application to Hanover College were compiled during the Fisher, Millis, and Parker administrations from 1902-1935. The applications for admission from 1939-1946 were part of the filing cabinets in Albert G. Parker's presidential files. The applications were removed from his papers and placed in this collection.

GENEALOGY RESEARCH HINT

The student records list the home address of the student, some family information, and contain the signature of the parent or guardian of the student.

RESTRICTIONS AND PERMISSIONS

Materials from the collection may be copied based on the policies and costs determined by the archives. Preference will be given to copying from copies already in the collection and not the original, fragile documents.

Permission to publish whole documents from the collection, or publication of these materials on the Internet, or any electronic environment, is not given for administrative documents of Hanover College.
