SCOPE AND CONTENT STATEMENT

Moore writes notes on theological lectures that it is assumed were from his studies for his Doctor of Divinity. It is possible that later lectures were from Moore himself when he became a minister.

BIOGRAPHICAL STATEMENT

Ambrose Y. Moore was a minister in Hanover, Indiana and received his Doctor of Divinity. He served as a member, treasurer, and secretary of the Hanover College Board of Trustees from 1866 to 1872 and from 1881 to 1904. He also wrote *History of Hanover College*, which was published in December 1900.

PROVENANCE

The collection appears to be given by Ambrose Y. Moore as part of the donation of his personal library to the college. The exact dates of the donation are not known.
