BIOGRAPHICAL STATEMENT

The Hanover Historical Club was organized December 21, 1892 at the home of Prof. Joshua B. Garritt. Several professors at Hanover College were proponents of the society. The club appears to have lasted until 1896 when the record stops.

The minutes book was likely donated by one of the Hanover College professors who attended the meetings or a Garritt family member. Due to it being donated in the early days of the college, there is not a record naming the donor or date of donation
