SCOPE AND CONTENT STATEMENT

The minutes of the Y.M.C.A. document the meetings from its organization in 1870 until 1877. The second minutes book is of the Y.W.C.A. meetings held from 1939 to 1947.

BIOGRAPHICAL STATEMENT

The Young Men Mutual Association was organized at Hanover College on September 19, 1870. In 1883 a YMCA hall was completed at Hanover and was the first such hall in the world. In April 1885 seventeen women formed the Y.W.C.A. at Hanover. (For further information on the YMCA, see Frank S. Baker's *Glimpses of Hanover's Past: 1827-1977*, p. 129-131.
