## **SCOPE AND CONTENT STATEMENT**

The collection contains photos of the Crowe family, the genealogy of John Finley Crowe and a genealogy of descendancy of Samuel S. Crowe, with emphasis on a portion of the family that lives in Australia. There is also a typescript copy of Samuel S. Crowe's diary from the Civil War and information on the soldiers who also fought in the 93<sup>rd</sup> infantry with Crowe.

## **BIOGRAPHICAL STATEMENT**

Samuel Stanhope Crowe was born on July 23, 1819 at Shelbyville, Shelby County, KY. He was the fourth child of John Finley and Ester (Alexander) Crowe. Mr. Crowe received his formal education at Hanover College, which his father founded. In 1863 he raised a company to take part in the Civil War and wrote a diary at this time. He was a captain for three years of Company "B" in the 93<sup>rd</sup> Indiana Volunteer Infantry. He was promoted to major, lieutenant, and colonel before he was mustered out of the service. After the war he practiced law for many years. He died in Palestine, Texas May 25, 1982.
