Agnes Brown Duggan was a native of Madison, IN. She was born to William T. and Mary Graham Brown in 1886. She was the sister of J. Graham Brown, a well known benefactor of Hanover College. Duggan lived in Tucson, Arizona for the last several years of her life. She died at age 83 in 1969 while visiting her brother in Louisville.
