SCOPE AND CONTENT STATEMENT

The collection consists of student essays by Pauline Ernst and Guy Hamilton.

BIOGRAPHICAL STATEMENT

Pauline Ernst was born on Sep. 2, 1874 in Madison, IN. She graduated from Hanover College in 1896 and was a teacher in Madison from 1896 to 1899. She spent one year from 1899 to 1900 in Siam and then in 1903 in China. She married G. W. Hamilton and lived in Madison, IN.

Guy Wheeler Hamilton was born in Lebanon, IN on Nov. 8, 1874. He earned a B.A. and an A.M. from Hanover College in 1896. He earned an M.D. from the University of Louisville in 1899. He served as a missionary in Siam from 1899 to 1900 and spent time in China beginning in 1903. He married Pauline Ernst and they lived in Madison, IN.
