SCOPE AND CONTENT STATEMENT

The two minute books of the Wabash Presbytery document the work of the Cumberland Presbyterian Church in Indiana from 1883-19071

BIOGRAPHICAL STATEMENT

The Wabash Presbytery is part of the Cumberland Presbyterian Church, which was a separate branch of Presbyterianism in Indiana. Eventually the church joined with the Presbyterian Church U.S.A.

PROVENANCE

Since Hanover College's roots are in Presbyterianism, many records throughout Indiana have been donated at various times to the Presbyterian Archives of Hanover College.

RESTRICTIONS AND PERMISSIONS

The records of the Presbyterian Archives are on deposit at Hanover College and according to the Book of Order (G-9.0406), Hanover College may only hold official records on deposit. All ownership rights to the records remain with the creators of the records (the local church), or in the case the church no longer exists, the presbytery owns the records or the successive church body.
