SCOPE AND CONTENT STATEMENT

The minutes of the LaPorte Presbytery are recorded from meetings held from 1844 to 1855 with a clerk's note written in 1878.

BIOGRAPHICAL STATEMENT

The details of the creation of the Laporte Presbytery are not included within the minute book, but it most have been created from Lake Presbytery as both presbyteries occupy the northwestern corner of Indiana. It is very likely that the presbytery was consolidated into the boundaries of Logansport Presbytery by 1870.

PROVENANCE

Since Hanover College's roots are in Presbyterianism, many records throughout Indiana have been donated at various times to the Presbyterian Archives of Hanover College.

RESTRICTIONS AND PERMISSIONS

The records of the Presbyterian Archives are on deposit at Hanover College and according to the Book of Order (G-9.0406), Hanover College may only hold official records on deposit. All ownership rights to the records remain with the creators of the records (the local church), or in the case the church no longer exists, the presbytery owns the records or the successive church body.

Permission to publish whole documents from the collection, or publication of these materials on the Internet, or any electronic environment, requires a written proposal and permission by the owner of the records.
