## **SCOPE AND CONTENT STATEMENT**

The bound volume includes pamphlets on Presbyterianism, Protestantism, Methodism, and Catholicism. There is also the inauguration address of James Blythe, Hanover College's 1<sup>st</sup> president and a Hanover College student essay (Niles).

## **PROVENANCE**

The book was owned by the Union Literary Society of Hanover College and was part of its library, which eventually became part of the Hanover College library and archives.

## **RESTRICTIONS AND PERMISSIONS**
