The collection contains religious pamphlets published in the 19<sup>th</sup> century. Sermons have been divided into the following topics: addresses given to the General Assembly, Synod, and Presbyterian Church levels; Thanksgiving, theological, historical, inaugural/ordination, disciplinarian, funeral, and general sermons. There are also a few church manuals.

## **PROVENANCE**

This is an artificial collection created by bringing the vast majority of the pamphlets on the subject of religion into a collection. The details of when these pamphlets were donated to Hanover College or how they were collected isn't known.

## **RESTRICTIONS AND PERMISSIONS**
