Free registration allows you to receive new issue alerts for up to 5 journal titles available in the Ingenta database.

ABC-CLIO (America: History and Life and Historical Abstracts)

CLIO Alert Profile allows you to set up alerts for up to ten searches for which you would like to receive updates of new records to your email. Click on *Create a New Profile* to set up a username and password. Your email is required to set up these alerts. Enter your e-mail address and to select desired journal title. BioOne will notify you instantly by email when the latest issues of journals on BioOne are published online. The body of the email will contain a table of contents of the issue in question and a link to the TOC on BioOne. You do not have to be a subscriber to BioOne to use this service.

Journal Alerts from Project MUSE allows you to set up alerts by journal names or by subject area or both. You will need to set up an alerts account with a username and password and an email address.
